The Purpose of the project is to provide wayfinding and education (Road/Street Marker) at the 60th Anniversary of the Civil Rights, of the first Sit-In in Maryland's State Capital - Annapolis. On November 25, 1960, 5 African Americans (3 men 2 women - Annapolis Five) walked into the Terminal Restaurant at the Greyhound Bus Station as asked to be served. They were promptly arrested setting off protests, picketing, and other sit-ins in the City of Annapolis. The current maker is behind a boat-bar and constantly being covered by posters and other promotions.
