Innovative Initiatives Inc., a 501(c)(3) non-profit subsidiary of Reasonable Tech Solutions Inc., embodies a profound commitment to bridging the digital divide in STEM education within Baltimore City. Founded on the technological expertise of Reasonable Tech Solutionsestablished in 2013 with a specialization in cybersecurity, network security, helpdesk services, computer repair, and trainingInnovative Initiatives emerged from a pivotal 2017 meeting between our CEO and community organizations concerned about the inaccessibility of affordable STEM education for local youth. This led to the launch of free, engaging STEM programs at the Langston Hughes Community Center and the YMCA on 33rd Street in 2018, aimed at sparking youth interest in STEM through hands-on activities like Minecraft Coding with Microsoft Corp, a Youth Build a Computer Program, and innovative Makey Labs projects.

Despite the interruption of our programs in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our dedication to making STEM education accessible remained unwavering. In 2022, after thorough consultations with community stakeholders and recognizing both the persistent need and growing interest among youth in STEM fields, Innovative Initiatives was founded. Our goal is to reduce the digital divide by offering free STEM programs and certification training to Baltimore City's youth aged 16-24, ensuring they have the opportunity to explore and excel in the increasingly important STEM landscape.
