Research supports nature as an effective therapeutic tool. Operation: THRIVING ACRES will create experiences that utilize plants, gardening, farming, and nature to empower individuals and groups of veterans whose lives have been affected by service-connected illness, injuries, disabilities, and post-traumatic stress disorder to achieve improvements in their cognitive, physical, social, emotional, and spiritual well-being. Veterans have spoken eloquently to us about their need for more opportunities to experience sacred grounding putting their hands in the dirt and reaping the therapeutic benefits of nurturing something that brings forth life. In addition to the therapeutic benefits, participants in this nature-based program will learn skills in herbal medicine-making. We will create a veteran-made label for their product brand. Sales of these items will support program expansion and vocational training and job opportunities for local veterans.

This project's building is acquired, construction design completed, and funding sources secured. We are shovel-ready to begin construction after receiving the state bond initiative support.

While this submission does not ask for supporting documents, we would be thrilled to offer copies of our completed design plan, lease agreement, loan application, conservation easement agreement, and grant funding letters from Upper Shore Regional and MARBIDCO. We also have a beautiful slide presentation on the programmatic details of Operation: THRIVING ACRES and support letters from Veterans working with us on this project.

The founder and CEO of MizMaryland is enrolled in the New York Botanical Garden's esteemed Therapeutic Horticulture certification program with a specialization serving Veterans populations. She has nearly completed the 200 hours of course requirements and has 100 hours of field work to finalize and graduate from the program.

We need more options for Veterans services on the Eastern Shore and Operation: THRIVING ACRES will help fill that void.

We have no acquisition costs. Apotheosis Farm is a partner within the #WeAreOne Alliance and is donating the barn in a 15-year shared use lease agreement with MizMaryland, Inc. (with options for renewal). Because we are renovating an existing structure, we do not have any permitting issues.

We are ready to go. Once again, our building has been acquired, our construction design is complete, and our funding sources have been secured. We are shovel-ready to begin construction after receiving the state bond initiative support. Thank you so much for your consideration of this worthy project.
