## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

Peace on Patuxent Inc. (POPi) is a non-profit respite home and day retreat, located in the City of Laurel. POPi's mission is to provide holistic support to women diagnosed with life-leveling cancer. Our vision is to provide a sanctuary that allows the women diagnosed with life-leveling cancer a place to decompress and recalibrate themselves. The organization is committed to providing a nurturing space that inspires hope, empowerment, peace, and enlightenment. The organization offers services on the property at no cost. POPi is committed to ensuring the womens emotional wellbeing while visiting the property and acknowledge physical distress that arises and persists. POPis committed to making required capital improvements, at the property, which ease emotional and physical distress, creating a less challenging environment for the women.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Many women diagnosed and treated for cancer have experienced some form of nerve damage i.e neuropathy, which results in weakness in the hands and feet. A weakness which interferes with their ability to perform tasks. This limitation can impede womens emotional well-being while visiting the property. POPis commitment is to create capital improvements on the two upper-level bathrooms measuring approx. 160 sq. ft. each, at the existing property, creating larger easy-to-navigate bathrooms at approx. 210 sq. ft. each. Equipping each bathroom with a walk-in shower and rails, comfort toilets, and lever handles. Such improvements will aid to ease the physical and emotional challenges that arise. Creating larger bathrooms that are less restrictive and easy to navigate aligns with the organizational goal of providing a nurturing space that inspires hope, empowerment, peace, and enlightenment.
