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This limited-access neighborhood abuts Kenilworth Avenue (MD201), is east of the Anacostia and immediately north of East West Highway (MD 410). The neighborhood has been and continues to be negatively impacted by the construction of the Purple Line. When finished, there will be a Purple Line Station within one-half mile of the neighborhood. However, large portions of the neighborhood lack sidewalks and streetlight to allow residents to safely walk to the new light rail system. This project includes the installation of new sidewalks, the upgraded stormwater inlets and streetlights.
