## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

Womens Institute of Torah Seminary & College (WITS) is an undergraduate college approved by the Maryland Higher Education Commission. With a focus on optimizing both office and laboratory environments, this project reflects our commitment to creating functional, state-of-the-art spaces that foster innovation and productivity, and contribute to student success.
