Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Underage Employees

This bill authorizes an alcoholic beverages licensee in Allegany County to employ an individual who is 16 or 17 years old, as long as that individual does not sell or serve alcoholic beverages. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2024.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill does not materially affect Allegany County operations or finances.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: An alcoholic beverages licensee in Allegany County may employ an individual who is at least 18 years of age, and this individual is allowed to sell or serve alcoholic beverages.
