House Bill 1491 (Delegate Rogers)

Health and Government Operations

General Provisions - Commemorative Days - Prince Hall Day

This bill requires the Governor to annually proclaim the second Sunday in September as Prince Hall Day. The bill takes effect July 1, 2024.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Commemorating Prince Hall Day does not affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Nineteen official commemorative days, seven months, and one week are recognized in State law, as shown in **Exhibit 1**. The Governor also must issue a proclamation each year encouraging citizens and other individuals to observe a moment of silence at 3:00 p.m. on Memorial Day to unite in remembrance and commemorate the heroic acts and efforts of Marylanders who have served and died in the U.S. Armed Forces.
