BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Agriculture Section 1–101(a) and (g), 10–2001, and 10–2002 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Agriculture Section 10-2003 and 10-2004 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture 1-101.



- 16 (a) There is a Maryland Farms and Families Program in the Department.
- 17 (b) The purpose of the Program is to double the purchasing power of food-insecure
- 18 Maryland residents with limited access to fresh fruits and vegetables and to increase
- 19 revenue for farmers through redemption of federal nutrition benefits at Maryland farmers
- 20 markets.

- 22 (a) There is a Maryland Farms and Families Fund.
- 23 (b) The purpose of the Fund is [to provide grants] to:
- 24 (1) [Nonprofit organizations that match] MATCH purchases made with
- 25 FMNP, SNAP, and WIC benefits at participating farmers markets and farm stands;
- 26 (2) [Nonprofit] SUPPORT NONPROFIT farmers markets to implement the
- 27 Program [at the farmers markets] BY PROVIDING LOGISTICAL AND MARKETING

5 6	(d) (1) The Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to \S 7–302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
7 8	(2) The State Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately, and the Comptroller shall account for the Fund.
9	(e) The Fund consists of:
10	(1) Money appropriated in the State budget to the Fund; and
11 12	(2) Any other money from any other source accepted for the benefit of the Fund.

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1 2 3 4	(b) Within 90 days after the end of a [grant cycle] CALENDAR YEAR, [a qualified nonprofit] AN organization OR PERSON that received [a grant] FUNDS in accordance with this subtitle shall submit a report to the Department that includes the following information:
5 6	(1) The names and locations of Maryland farmers markets that received funds under the Program;
7 8	(2) The dollar amount of funds awarded to each participating farmers market;
9 10 11	(3) The dollar amount of FMNP, SNAP, and WIC benefits, and funds provided under the Program that were spent at participating farmers markets, as well as any unspent funds;
12 13	(4) The number of FMNP, SNAP, and WIC transactions carried out at participating farmers markets; and
14 15 16	(5) The impact of the Program on increasing the quantity of fresh fruits and vegetables consumed by FMNP, SNAP, and WIC families, as determined by customer surveys.
17 18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
