### **Article – General Provisions**

1 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2 AS ITALIAN HERITAGE MONTH IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT 3 ITALIAN AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE.

4 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 5 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE ITALIAN HERITAGE MONTH PROPERLY WITH 6 APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
1, 2025.
