FOR the purpose of requiring certain public and nonpublic schools to notify a parent or 5 6 guardian if a student attempts or accomplishes an elopement from the school campus 7 except under certain circumstances; establishing certain reporting requirements for 8 certain public and nonpublic schools and the State Department of Education 9 regarding incidents of student elopement from school; requiring the Department to develop a certain accountability system; requiring certain schools and individualized 10 education program teams to review and address with relevant stakeholders certain 11 behavior in updating a student's individualized education program or behavior 12 intervention plan; and generally relating to student elopement and public and 13 nonpublic schools. 14
