- 3 WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 4 (C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO ALLOW THE CONSUMPTION
- 5 OF LIQUOR FOR TASTING IF:

- 7 (2) THE CONSUMER IS NOT CHARGED FOR THE LIQUOR.
