## 1 AN ACT concerning

## State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers, Appraisal Management Companies, and Home Inspectors – Sunset Extension and Report

- 4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers, Appraisal 5 Management Companies, and Home Inspectors in accordance with the provisions of 6 the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date 7 the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the 8 Commission; requiring the Maryland Department of Labor to submit a report with 9 information regarding the Commission to the Joint Audit and Evaluation Committee 10 on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Commission of Real 11 Estate Appraisers, Appraisal Management Companies, and Home Inspectors.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – Business Occupations and Professions
16–201.
There is a State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers, Appraisal Management Companies, and Home Inspectors in the Department.
16–802.
Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2026] 2021.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before July 1, 2028, the Maryland Department of Labor shall submit a report to the Joint Audit and Evaluation Committee with information regarding the State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers, Appraisal Management Companies, and Home Inspectors as determined by the Joint Audit and Evaluation Committee.
SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2025.
