BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Health – General Section 19-210 Annotated Code of Maryland (2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Health - General 19–210. In this section, "Fund" means the Maternal and Child Health Population Health Improvement Fund.
