BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10-409 Annotated Code of Maryland (2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 10-409.(A) Pursuant to IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10–205 of this title, the Department shall establish and publish by April 25 each year the bag limits per day for game birds and mammals by regulation for the ensuing year.
