Co. 5-25 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to enter into certain use agreements to facilitate the use of motor vehicles and motorized equipment for 7 the purpose of maintaining certain paths within the Patuxent River Wildland; and 8 generally relating to the Patuxent River Wildland. BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 5–1212 Annotated Code of Maryland (2023 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) 14SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 15That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article – Natural Resources 165 - 1212. 17

18 (A) Except as provided in Part II of this subtitle, and subject to existing private 19rights, a commercial enterprise or permanent road, except fire roads, may not exist within 20any wildlife area designated by Part II of this subtitle.

Except as necessary to meet minimum requirements for the 21**(B)** (1) 22administration of the area for the purpose of Part II of this subtitle, including measures 23required in emergencies involving the health and safety of persons within the area, AND

#### **SENATE BILL 968**

1 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, there shall be no 2 temporary road, use of motor vehicles, motorized equipment, motorboats, landing of 3 aircraft, or other forms of mechanical transport, and no structure or installation within any 4 area.

5 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO USE AGREEMENTS WITH 6 VOLUNTEERS TO FACILITATE THE USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND MOTORIZED 7 EQUIPMENT WITHIN THE PATUXENT RIVER WILDLAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF 8 MAINTAINING EXISTING PATHS TO ENSURE CLEAR AND SAFE ACCESS TO THE 9 WILDLAND.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2025.
