A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Financing Act – Fair Campaign Financing Fund – Distributions**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the earliest date on which the State Board of Elections may
4 begin making distributions from the Fair Campaign Financing Fund; and generally
5 relating to distributions from the Fair Campaign Financing Fund.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Election Law**
19 15–102.

20 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

21 (f) “Fund” means the Fair Campaign Financing Fund.

22 15–107.

1 (a) (1) In accordance with subsection (c) of this section and regulations
2 adopted by the State Board, the State Board shall authorize distribution of money in the
3 Fund on a continuing basis on certification that the qualifications under § 15–104 of this
4 title have been met.

5 (2) Distributions shall begin not earlier than **[January] JULY** 1 of the year
6 **[of] BEFORE** the election.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
8 1, 2026.
