## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicle Administration – Identification Cards, Licenses, and Permits**  
3 **– Repeal of Color Photograph Requirement**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the photograph included on an  
5 identification card, a driver's license, or a moped operator's permit issued by the  
6 Motor Vehicle Administration be in color; and generally relating to the Motor Vehicle  
7 Administration and identification card, license, and permit requirements.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Transportation**

21 12–301.

22 (a) On application, the Administration shall issue an identification card to any  
23 applicant who:

1 (1) Is a resident of this State;

2 (2) Does not have a driver's license;

3 (3) Presents a birth certificate or other proof of age and identity acceptable  
4 to the Administration;

5 (4) Provides satisfactory documentary evidence that the applicant has  
6 lawful status;

7 (5) (i) Provides satisfactory documentary evidence that the applicant  
8 has a valid Social Security number by presenting the applicant's Social Security  
9 Administration account card or, if the Social Security Administration account card is not  
10 available, any of the following documents bearing the applicant's Social Security number:

11 1. A current W-2 form;

12 2. A current SSA-1099 form;

13 3. A current non-SSA-1099 form; or

14 4. A current pay stub with the applicant's name and Social  
15 Security number on it; or

16 (ii) Provides satisfactory documentary evidence that the applicant is  
17 not eligible for a Social Security number; and

18 (6) Presents a completed application for an identification card on a form  
19 furnished by the Administration.

20 (g) (2) The card shall contain:

21 (v) A [color] photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that  
22 the Administration requires;

23 16-111.1.

24 (d) (2) A noncommercial Class A, B, C, or M license shall include:

25 (iv) A [color] photograph of the applicant that is taken in accordance  
26 with a procedure that the Administration requires;

27 16-122.

28 (d) Each identification card, moped operator's permit, and license to drive issued  
29 or renewed in accordance with this section shall:

1                   (3) Be of the size and design that the Administration requires,  
2 tamperproof, to the extent possible, and contain:

3                   (v) A [color] photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that  
4 the Administration requires;

5           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2026.
