A BILL ENTITLED

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Business Regulation**

22 11–404.

23 (d) (1) If 140 or more days of live racing in a year are held at Laurel Race

24 Course, the Comptroller shall pay:

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(i) for each day of live racing, \$2,000 to Anne Arundel County, \$500 to Howard County, and \$300 to the City of Laurel; and

(ii) for each additional day of intertrack betting without live racing held, \$1,000 to Anne Arundel County, \$250 to Howard County, and \$150 to the City of Laurel.

(2) If fewer than 140 days of live racing in a year are held at Laurel Race Course, the Comptroller shall pay:

(i) for each day of live racing or each day of intertrack betting without live racing held, up to a maximum payment for 140 days, \$2,000 to Anne Arundel County, \$500 to Howard County, and \$300 to the City of Laurel; and

(ii) for each additional day of intertrack betting without live racing held, \$1,000 to Anne Arundel County, \$250 to Howard County, and \$150 to the City of Laurel.

(b) (1) By the end of the month following collection, the Comptroller shall deposit, cause to be deposited, or pay:

(xiii) after June 30, 2024, a supplemental local impact grant of \$3,000,000 each fiscal year to the County Executive and County Council of Prince George's County from the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all lotteries after the distributions under subsection (a) of this section and items (i) through (xii) of this paragraph to be distributed in Prince George's County in accordance with § 9–1A–31 of this title; [and]

(XIV) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION AFTER JUNE 30, 2025, SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL IMPACT AID OF \$500,000 EACH FISCAL YEAR FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE RACETRAX LOTTERY GAME TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, HOWARD COUNTY, AND THE CITY OF LAUREL IN PROPORTION TO EACH JURISDICTION'S SHARE OF THE MONEY REQUIRED TO BE PAID UNDER § 11–404(D) OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE TO BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND

[(xiv)] (XV) into the General Fund of the State the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all lotteries after the distributions under subsection (a) of this section and items (i) through **[(xiii)] (XIV)** of this paragraph.

1 **(3) THE COMPTROLLER MAY NOT PAY THE SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL**
2 **IMPACT AID REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(XIV) OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR ANY**
3 **FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE FISCAL YEAR THAT:**

4 **(I) LAUREL RACE COURSE IS NO LONGER USED FOR LIVE**
5 **RACING OR TRAINING; OR**

6 **(II) BACKSTRETCH WORKERS EMPLOYED AT LAUREL RACE**
7 **COURSE ARE NO LONGER LIVING ON THE LAUREL RACE COURSE PROPERTY.**

8 **(4) (I) ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, HOWARD COUNTY, AND THE**
9 **CITY OF LAUREL SHALL USE THE SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL IMPACT AID REQUIRED**
10 **UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(XIV) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO PROVIDE PROGRAMS AND**
11 **SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITIES SURROUNDING LAUREL RACE COURSE**
12 **INCLUDING:**

- 13 1. **HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES;**
- 14 2. **INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY COUNSELING;**
- 15 3. **DRUG AND ALCOHOL ADDICTION AWARENESS,**
16 **SUPPORT, AND TREATMENT;**
- 17 4. **SOCIAL SERVICES;**
- 18 5. **NUTRITION AND WELLNESS PROGRAMS; AND**
- 19 6. **TRANSPORTATION, IF NECESSARY, TO OFF-SITE**
20 **MEDICAL AND WELLNESS SERVICES.**

21 **(II) 1. ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY MAY USE THE**
22 **SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL IMPACT AID UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(XIV) OF THIS**
23 **SUBSECTION ONLY TO PROVIDE GRANT FUNDING FOR THE PURPOSES IDENTIFIED**
24 **UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS:**

25 **A. WITH A HISTORY OF WORKING WITH BACKSTRETCH**
26 **WORKERS EMPLOYED AT LAUREL RACE COURSE; AND**

27 **B. THAT EMPLOY SPANISH-SPEAKING PROGRAM STAFF**
28 **OR PROVIDE TRANSLATION SERVICES FOR NONNATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS.**

29 2. **A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT RECEIVES GRANT**
30 **FUNDING UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH MAY USE THE FUNDING ONLY TO PROVIDE**

1 PROGRAMS AND SERVICES AT LAUREL RACE COURSE OR WITHIN 1 MILE OF LAUREL
2 RACE COURSE TO BACKSTRETCH WORKERS EMPLOYED AT LAUREL RACE COURSE
3 OR RESIDENTS LIVING IN THE 20724 POSTAL ZIP CODE.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2025.
