<p>2016 Whitemarsh Park Project Bond Bill Background</p> <p>During the 2014 legislative session, the State approved a bond bill for the Bowie Boys and Girls Club Pole Barn Structure in the City of Bowie in Prince George's County; DGS Item G173, Chapter 463, Acts of 2014- \$100,000. This project was to be developed at the city-owned Jericho Park. The bond bill was given to the Bowie Boys and Girls Club as the grantee. It has been determined that the proposed project cannot be built due to site constraints. The current request for the legislature is to provide authorization to use these funds for another project on a different city-owned park, Whitemarsh Park, for a different project (design/build a restroom/concession building), which will still provide a significant service for the Bowie Boys and Girls Club.</p>

During the 2014 legislative session, the State approved a bond bill for the Bowie Boys and Girls Club Pole Barn Structure in the City of Bowie in Prince George's County; DGS Item G173, Chapter 463, Acts of 2014- \$100,000. This project was to be developed at the city-owned Jericho Park. The bond bill was given to the Bowie Boys and Girls Club as the grantee. It has been determined that the proposed project cannot be built due to site constraints. The current request for the legislature is to provide authorization to use these funds for another project on a different city-owned park, Whitemarsh Park, for a different project (design/build a restroom/concession building), which will still provide a significant service for the Bowie Boys and Girls Club.
