HOUSE BILL INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 20, 2019

HB 1379 Delegate B. Barnes

OPTIONAL RETIREMENT PROGRAM – MEMBERSHIP

Prohibiting certain individuals who are members of the Employees' Pension System of the State Retirement and Pension System from becoming a member of the Optional Retirement Program of the State Retirement and Pension System on or after February 1, 2015.

COMMERCIAL LAW – SELF-SERVICE STORAGE FACILITIES – LATE FEES

Increasing the limit on the late fees an operator of a self-service storage facility may charge an occupant from 20% to 25% of the monthly rent for the leased space for each month the occupant does not pay rent when due.

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HB 1381 Delegate Conaway**PUBLIC SCHOOLS – EDUCATION ON THE CONSEQUENCES OF JUVENILE CRIMINAL ACTIVITY**

Requiring the State Board of Education to develop and implement a program of education on the consequences of juvenile criminal activity that includes instruction on the direct consequences of and the ways in which juvenile criminal activity can indirectly affect an individual's life; and requiring each county board of education to ensure that the program is implemented in each public middle school in the county and the instruction is provided to each student at least once during grades 6 through 8.

HB 1382 Delegates Clippinger and Barron**LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' BILL OF RIGHTS – HEARING BY HEARING BOARD – PUBLIC INFORMATION**

Requiring that, if a certain trial board hearing is open to the public, certain advance notice of the hearing shall be given to the public, a certain agenda shall be made available to the public, and an official record of the hearing to include the decision of the hearing board shall be provided to a member of the public on request.

HB 1383 Delegate Jackson**CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM – MEMBERSHIP – MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEES**

Altering the membership of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System to include certain individuals in certain positions in the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services on or after July 1, 2019; requiring a certain transfer and combination of certain service credit for certain individuals; requiring the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System to calculate a certain disability benefit for certain individuals and to grant a certain benefit under certain circumstances; etc.
