# **SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 20, 2019**

# **SB 988** Senator King

#### VIDEO LOTTERY OPERATION LICENSE – RENEWAL

Altering from 1 year to 2 years, the number of years before the end of the term of a video lottery operation license that a licensee may apply for renewal of the license; providing for a 10–year term for a renewed license; requiring the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission to renew a certain license unless the Commission finds the licensee is no longer qualified; requiring the Commission, before denying an application, to provide a licensee an opportunity for a hearing; etc.

## SB 989 Senator Carozza, et al

PUBLIC SCHOOLS – FUNDAMENTALS OF CONSTRUCTION – ELECTIVE COURSE

Authorizing a county board of education to offer an elective course in fundamentals of construction in schools under the jurisdiction of the county board.

## **SB 990** Senator Ferguson

#### STATE BUDGET

Proposing an amendment to the Maryland Constitution authorizing the General Assembly to increase or add Executive Department items in the budget bill, subject to a certain limitation; providing for the veto by the Governor of only those items relating to the Executive Department that have been increased or added by the General Assembly; providing for the reversion to original appropriations of certain vetoed items in the budget bill; authorizing the General Assembly to override budget bill item vetoes; etc.

#### SB 991 Senator McCray

BALTIMORE CITY – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – CLASS B–D–7 LICENSE

Authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City to issue a Class B–D–7 license in a certain area of the 45th alcoholic beverages district if the applicant meets certain requirements.

#### PRESCRIPTION MONITORING DATA – HEALTH CARE FACILITY

Requiring the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program to disclose prescription monitoring data, in accordance with certain regulations, to the medical director or authorized administrator of certain health care facilities, or the medical director's or authorized administrator's designee, for the purpose of providing medical or pharmaceutical treatment to a patient or prospective patient of the health care facility.

## SB 993 Senator Hester, et al

TASK FORCE TO STUDY BEHAVIORAL AND MENTAL HEALTH IN MARYLAND

Establishing the Task Force to Study Behavioral and Mental Health in Maryland; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2020; etc.

#### **SB 994** Senators Ellis and Benson

STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS – APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS

Repealing a certain balloting and nomination process to select the names of certain candidates to submit to the Governor to be members of the State Board of Dental Examiners; requiring the Board, within a certain period of time, to notify certain practicing licensees and professional organizations of a vacancy on the Board, provide certain information, solicit certain nominations for the vacancy, and forward certain nominations and petitions to the Governor; and authorizing the Governor to fill a vacancy on the Board in a certain manner.

#### SB 995 Senator Serafini

SALES AND USE TAX – TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY – OFFICE COUNTERS AND CABINETS

Excluding counters, countertops, or cabinetry installed in residential or commercial office spaces if the counters, countertops, or cabinetry are affixed or attached to the real estate and sold on a furnished and installed basis from the definition of "tangible personal property" that is taxable under the sales and use tax; etc.

GENERAL PROVISIONS – COMMEMORATIVE DAYS – WELCOME HOME KOREAN WAR VETERANS DAY

Providing that July 27 each year is Welcome Home Korean War Veterans Day in recognition of the service and sacrifice of Korean War veterans.
