SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 22, 2019

SB 1002 Senators Hershey and Eckardt

COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION – ESTABLISHING REGIONAL CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS – AUTHORITY AND FUNDING

Authorizing the county boards of education in Caroline, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, and Talbot counties and an institution of higher education located within the regional counties to establish a regional career and technical education school subject to certain requirements; requiring the State to distribute to the county boards a certain amount for certain expenses and 100% of school construction funding; requiring the county boards to use certain funds only for a certain purpose; etc.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.

SB 1003 Senator Lee**CRIMINAL LAW – SALE OR DISPLAY OF OBSCENE ITEM TO MINOR
– VIDEO IMAGE**

Altering the definition of “item” as it relates to a certain prohibition against selling or displaying a certain obscene item to a minor by including a motion picture, an image, a visual representation, a video file, a video image, or a video recording; and providing a person who violates the Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject, for a first violation, to imprisonment of up to 1 year or a fine of up to \$1,000 or both, and, for each subsequent violation, imprisonment of up to 3 years or a fine of up to \$5,000 or both.

SB 1004 Senators Pinsky and Jennings**ELECTION LAW – ELECTION CALENDAR AND PROCESSES –
REVISIONS**

Altering the date by which the Clerk of the Court of Appeals and the Clerk of the Court of Special Appeals must provide a certain notice to the State Board of Elections; repealing the requirement that the Anne Arundel County Board of Education provide a certain notice to the State Board; altering the deadline for the filing of a certain certificate of candidacy; altering the deadline for the filing of a certain petition to challenge a certain candidate’s residency; etc.
