EDUCATION – REPORTING ARRESTS OF STUDENTS –
ALTERATIONS

Requiring a certain law enforcement agency to report a certain arrest of a certain student to the Maryland Center for School Safety, the State Board of Education, and the State's Attorney; requiring the State's Attorney to notify the Center and the State Board of the disposition of a certain reportable offense; authorizing the Center and the State Board to transmit certain information as a confidential file to a certain county superintendent of schools or a certain nonpublic school under certain circumstances; etc.

CRIMINAL LAW – THIRD-DEGREE ASSAULT

Altering the elements of the crime of first-degree assault by including an alternative prohibition against committing a battery with a firearm; altering the elements of the crime of second-degree assault by including an alternative prohibition against committing a battery causing physical injury; prohibiting a person from committing a battery; establishing and applying certain penalties for a violation of the Act; etc.
