HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 3, 2020

HB 1658 Delegate McIntosh

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – BALTIMORE SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA – FUNDING AND REPORTING

Requiring the Governor to appropriate certain amounts of money to the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra in fiscal years 2022 through 2026; requiring the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra to submit certain reports to the Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly on or before October 15 each year, beginning in 2022 and for the next 4 years; and repealing the termination of a certain provision of law requiring the Governor to appropriate a certain amount of money to the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra in fiscal years 2020 and 2021.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.

MARYLAND STADIUM AUTHORITY – YOUTH AND AMATEUR
SPORTS GRANTS PROGRAM AND FUND

Establishing the Youth and Amateur Sports Grants Program to provide grants from the Youth and Amateur Sports Fund to bring new youth and amateur events to the State and attract sports fans, participants, and tourists; requiring Maryland Sports to implement and administer the Program in a certain manner; requiring the Comptroller to distribute a certain amount of money from the State Lottery Fund to the Youth and Amateur Sports Fund each fiscal year; etc.
