House Bill 377 (MC 11-20) creates a consumption only marketplace license to be issued to the developer of a commercial property and allow for the consumption of beer, wine, and liquor in a designated outdoor area located within the commercial shopping area.

MCCC Board Member company Federal Realty Investment Trust (FRIT) has brought tremendous economic development to an area in North Bethesda, designated as the "Pike & Rose" district. What was once a static shopping plaza is now a dynamic and vibrant area. This area has apartment buildings, restaurants of all kinds, a movie theater, performances hall, a hotel, and shops.

By creating an annual consumption-only marketplace license, the state is supporting FRIT in the creation of a community within Pike & Rose. Further, it greatly improves the administrative time and paperwork as currently developers must apply for daily licenses individually, when needed.

For the aforementioned reasons, MCCC urges a favorable report on House Bill 377 (MC 11-20).
