Baltimore County **SUPPORTS** Senate Bill 28 – Solid Waste Management - Prohibition on Releasing a Balloon Into the Atmosphere. This bill would prohibit a person from releasing a balloon into the atmosphere or organizing an event in which balloons are released into the atmosphere, and authorizes the Department of the Environment to impose a civil fine for violating this statute.

We have long known the detrimental effects the use and presence of plastic has had on our environment. When a balloon is intentionally released into the air and pops, the resulting non-biodegradable material can fall in our waterways, forests, and streets. County Executive Olszewski is passionate about preserving the environment and firmly believes that any attempt to reduce the introduction of plastics and microplastics into our ecosystem is worth supporting. This bill takes a long-needed step in that direction.
