The Maryland Board of Acupuncture is submitting this letter of Information for SB 103 - Health Occupations - Diagnostic Evaluation and Treatment of Patients - Disciplinary Actions.

SB 103, as written, applies to all Health Occupational Boards and respective health care practitioners. The Board of Acupuncture is unclear how the bill would apply to the practice of Acupuncture and East Asian Medicine, as East Asian Medicine, by its nature, is integrative, complementary, alternative and sometimes non-conventional.

We urge the Committee to consider the applicability of this bill in relation to the Acupuncture Board or other alternative health care professions.
