The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the "Board") is submitting this letter of support for Senate Bill 355 – Health Occupations - Pharmacists - Administration of Vaccinations.

By homogenizing the requirements for pharmacists to administer vaccines, this bill will create a less burdensome framework for pharmacists to navigate when administering vaccinations. By lowering the minimum patient age from 11 years to 9 years, the Board believes that this measure will expand access to necessary care. This promotes the Board's mission of promoting quality health care in the field of p harmacy. For these reasons, the Board of Pharmacy supports this measure.
