## Maryland Council on Health in All Policies - Establishment - HB 1528 - Factsheet

### What Does HB1528 Do?

- Creates a Maryland Council on Health in All Policies (HiAP Council) that will consider human health in all future decision making
- HiAP Council will recommend policy in all legislative areas that prioritizes human health, reduces inequities, and improves Maryland health outcomes.

#### Why Is This Legislation Important?

- Marylanders experience negative health outcomes due to a variety of sources, including:
  - Lack of affordable housing that is associated with higher exposures to environmental pollution.
  - Poor quality education that restricts future employment opportunities. This results in lower incomes and makes healthcare costs even more burdensome.
  - Failures in public transport that delay patients from seeing their doctors and accessing pharmacies.
  - Barriers to career promotion and success that compound these challenges.
- Incorporating health into all sectors of policy will enable Maryland to better anticipate and mitigate the human health consequences of legislative decision making.

### Who Will Be On This Council?

- The Council will be composed of a broad coalition of elected officials, state agency members and health experts who reflect the racial, ethnic, cultural, geographic, and gender diversity of Maryland.
