Human Relations – Employment Discrimination – Waiver of Immunity From Suit in Federal Court and Venue

Issue:

- United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit ruled in *Pense v. Maryland Dept of Public Safety and Correctional Services* that Maryland is immune to employment discrimination lawsuits in federal court
- The court found that the waiver of sovereign immunity in State Government § 20-903 wasn't specific enough to include federal courts
- Maryland employees will be limited in their ability to redress employment discrimination
- *Pense* may also prevent housing discrimination suits from being filed against the state in federal court

What SB 250 does:

- Prohibits the state from raising a sovereign immunity defense in discrimination cases
- Permits employment and housing discrimination cases against the state to be filed in federal court or state court
