Decriminalizing Paraphenalia FAVORABLE Testimony by Deborah Agus, JD HB0720

Addiction is a brain disease and it is imperative that we use every possible tool to increase our response in saving lives and promoting treatment. Every step towards this goal is worthwhile. To the contrary, every single barrier in the way of promoting health and saving lives must be removed.
