The average inmate waiting to enter my school read around the 5th grade level. Most inmates have failed school for one reason or another. Many have bad memories about their school failures. We can force some inmates to attend school and others we cannot force to enter school. This bill would encourage more inmates to enter and successfully complete school.

We know from numerous studies that inmates who are successful with educational programs in prison are less likely to return. This benefits the individual, their families, our society and reduces state expenditures through a reduction in recidivism.
