

**All rifle and shotgun transfers would require a point-of-sale background check**

When an **unlicensed seller** transfers a rifle or shotgun, a federally licensed firearm dealer would facilitate the transfer, including the background check, in accordance with state and federal law

**Some rifle and shotgun transfers would be exempted from the point-of-sale background check requirement**

Exempt *Final* transfers

- Involving a licensed dealer
- Immediate family
- Law Enforcement and military
- Curios, relics, and unservicable weapons
- Inheritances

Exempt *Temporary* transfers

- To prevent harm
- While hunting
- Shooting ranges, competitions and performances
- In presence of the owner

If buying from a **licensed dealer**, the dealer conducts the transfer in accordance with state and federal law

There are no such exceptions when purchasing from a licensed dealer
