HB 910 would eliminate the ability for individuals to manufacture or possess homemade firearms, activities that have been considered legal for the entire history of the United States. Given the incredible rarity of homemade firearms being used in any crimes, it is highly improbable that this bill will result in a measurable improvement to public safety.
