WRITTEN TESTIMONY OF SCOTT D. SHELLENBERGER, STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR BALTIMORE COUNTY, IN OPPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 550 MAKING POSSESSION OF ONE OUNCE OF MARIJUANA LEGAL
