Ways and Means Committee

- This bill is a local bill request for a statutory provision to include Carroll County's four JROTC instructors in the teachers' union, Carroll County Education Association (CCEA)
- As of now, the four JROTC employees in Carroll County are not designated as part of an employee association. By state law, unless there is reason to exclude them from union representation, each position must be designated for representation.
- A similar bill was needed years ago to include registered nurses in the CCEA through a statutory provision.

<u>The counties that currently have similar provisions for their JROTC</u> <u>Employees:</u> Baltimore County, Calvert, Charles, Garrett, Prince George's, and St. Mary's
