The Maryland Building Industry Association, representing 1,100 member firms statewide, appreciates the opportunity to participate in the discussion surrounding HB 1023 (Real Property – Condominiums, Homeowners Associations, and Cooperative Housing Corporations – Virtual Meetings). MBIA Supports the Act in its current version.

This bill would allow the governing body of a condominium, homeowners association, or cooperative housing corporation to hold meetings electronically. MBIA supports this measure. Allowing meetings to be held electronically would make meeting easier to organize and more widely available and convenient for members to attend. Additionally, during the current pandemic limiting gatherings of people for meetings that can easily be conducted electronically is a matter of public safety. This was certainly an issue during COVID-19, however, we believe that is should be carried forward in to the future.

For these reasons, MBIA respectfully requests the Committee give this measure a favorable report. Thank you for your consideration.
