The Maryland Veterans Caucus respectfully requests a favorable report on HB-371 State Lottery - Instant Ticket Lottery Machines - Fraternal Organizations (ITLMs for Homeless Veterans Act)

This bill was sponsored by **Delegate Pat Young** for the purpose authorizing the Director of the State Lottery and Gaming Control 4 Agency to issue certain fraternal organizations a license for not more than a certain 5 number of instant ticket lottery machines for the sale of certain instant lottery 6 tickets under certain circumstances; providing for the distribution of the proceeds 7 from certain lottery machine ticket sales by a fraternal organization; declaring the 8 intent of the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the 9 operation of and proceeds from instant ticket lottery machines in the State.

The Veterans Caucus mission is to study, develop and promote legislation designed to improve the quality of life for veterans in the State of Maryland in the areas of employment, education, economic, training and health, and to assist the Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs in achieving its mission and goals, on behalf of veterans in the State.
