The Maryland Community Health Resources Commission (CHRC) is pleased to submit this letter of support for SB 802 - Maryland Consortium on Coordinated Community Supports – Membership and Coordinated Community Supports Partnership Fund – Revisions.

This bill as amended would make a few modest adjustments as the CHRC prepares to staff and launch the new Consortium. These adjustments include adding additional members to the Consortium; clarifying the responsibilities of the CHRC; increasing the funding for the Consortium beginning in Fiscal Year 2024; and adding two additional PINs to the CHRC as we prepare to implement the Act.

The CHRC looks forward to staffing the new Maryland Consortium on Coordinating Community Supports and supporting the policy objectives to expand access to behavioral health services contemplated under Chapter 36 from 2021. We look forward to working with you and the Members of the Maryland General Assembly in the coming weeks and months as the important work of the Consortium begins.
