The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (the Board) is submitting this letter of support for House Bill (HB) 229 – Pharmacists – Administration of Maintenance Injectable Medications – Treatment of Sexually Transmitted Infections.

HB 229 would amend the definition of "maintenance injectable medication" to specifically include a medication that "treats a sexually transmitted infection and is not a vaccine."

The Board supports the appropriate expansion of the practice of pharmacy and recognizes the importance of increasing access to treatment for Marylanders.
