in the "Maryland Health Equity Resource Act" (Chap. 742, 2021) enacted by the Maryland General

The Maryland Health Equity Resource Act provides significant new resources to be administered by the CHRC to reduce health disparities, improve health outcomes, and reduce avoidable hospitalizations. Chapter 742 (2021) established the "Pathways to Health Equity Fund", to support two-year programs to reduce health disparities and help lay the groundwork for future "Health Equity Resource Communities" (HERCs). Chapter 742 (2021) also established a second fund, "The Health Equity Resource Community" fund, to support projects in the out-years of the program. After the execution of the two-year Pathways grants, the CHRC is directed to issue a second Call for Proposals to establish new "Health Equity Resource Communities" (HERCs).

On February 15, 2022, the CHRC Commissioners voted to award nine new grant awards under the Pathways to Heath Equity program to support new programs across the state in urban, rural, and suburban areas across the state (attached is a summary of these new programs). Under Chapter 742 (2021), these projects are two-year projects that are designed to help lay the groundwork for future HERCs. These Pathways projects will begin implementation this spring and are expected to conclude in the spring of 2024. SB 906 will change the release date of the HERC Call for Proposals from October 2022 to October 2023, which will enable the nine new Pathways grantees additional time to implement their two-year programs, collect and report outcome data, and respond to the second HERC RFP. In addition, HB 906 will enable the CHRC to utilize the new HERC Fund to cover the CHRC's staffing costs (included

in the Governor's budget for FY 2023) and the costs of a contract with Chesapeake Regional Information Systems for our Patients (CRISP).

The CHRC requests a favorable report of HB 906 from the Health & Government Operations Committee and we look forward to working with you and Members of the Maryland General Assembly as the CHRC continues to implement the Maryland Health Equity Resource Act.
