Legislation: HB 1250 Maryland Solar Investment Tax Credit and Task Force to Study Solar Energy Incentives

Allowing a taxpayer to claim a credit against the State income tax for certain costs incurred to install certain solar energy property; requiring the Maryland Energy Administration to administer the credit; providing for the carryforward and transfer of the credit under certain circumstances; and establishing the Task Force to Study Solar Energy Incentives and make recommendations regarding measures needed to ensure that solar development in the State creates good quality, family-sustaining jobs.
