## SPONSOR TESTIMONY House Bill 725- Children - Therapeutic Child Care Program - Funding

Madame Chair, Members of the Ways and Means Committee,

I believe every child in Maryland has a basic right to receive the support needed to foster their growth. Therapeutic child care programs provide support to our particular populations of Maryland youth who face significant challenges through specialized child care. These programs provide channels of intensive individualized support for children under the age of six years old with severe trauma, behavioral health challenges, and developmental delays. And they have an extraordinary success rate, transitioning more than 80% of participating children to a typical kindergarten environment.

HB 725 is intended to create a permanent funding stream for therapeutic child care programs across the state. By providing a secure funding stream, we can ensure that Maryland children who need this kind of specialized care are able to get it. I urge the committee to issue a favorable report, and ensure all children in Maryland have access to high quality child care, regardless of their needs.
