HB 372 – Higher Education – Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship – Name Change February 14, 2023

Dear Chair Barnes and Members of the Appropriations Committee:

The Maryland Military Coalition (MMC) **strongly supports HB 372**, which will change the name of the Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship to the **Douglas J.J. Peters Veterans of the Afghanistan and Iraq Conflicts Scholarship**.

The proposed name change is a fitting tribute to a Marylander who served his nation and his state with distinction. A graduate of the University of Maryland, Senator Peters served as an Army officer, including deployment during Operation Desert Storm. He was awarded the Bronze Star for his service in theater.

As you all know, Senator Peters held a variety of leadership positions in the Maryland State Senate, including serving as Majority Leader, and chairing a wide variety of subcommittees.

Most importantly, Senator Peters was a staunch advocate and supporter of Maryland veterans. Whenever veterans had a concern or an interest in legislation, Senator Peters always listened, got to the bottom of the issue and took action. He was one of the finest friends veterans have ever had in the General Assembly.

Accordingly, renaming the scholarship in his honor is a fitting tribute to his lengthy service as an Army officer, legislator and supporter of Maryland veterans.
