Testimony in Favor of HB0662 Real Estate Brokers, Salespersons, and Associate Brokers – Continuing Education Courses Alterations

Chair Wilson, Vice-Chair Crosby, and members of the Economic Matters Committee,

I respectfully request a favorable report of HB0662. This bill is altering the requirements for the subject matter of continuing education courses for licensees issued an initial license by the State Real Estate Commission; and generally relating to continuing education courses for real estate brokers, salespersons, and associate brokers.

Under current law, all real estate licensees are required to take 15-hours of continuing education every two years. Current continuing education courses cover some mandated topics and certain licensees -- like brokers and real estate team leaders – must take specific courses within the 15 hours. This legislation will not increase continuing education hours for new licensees but will mandate a specific set of courses different than the courses taken by existing licensees.

- Specifically, the bill lays out several areas of instruction for new licensees, such as:
 - Advertising requirements
 - o Handling of escrow funds
 - Landlord and tenant law
 - o Contract writing, contingencies and regional contract differences
 - o Financing

I respectfully request a favorable report on HB0662.
