TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 274

Task Force on Reducing Emergency Department Wait Times Before the House Health and Government Operations Committee By Anna Trejo February 21, 2023

Honorable Chair Peña-Melnyk and Members of the House Health and Government Operations Committee, thank you for this opportunity to testify in favor of House Bill 274 which would create a task force on reducing emergency department wait times. Last week I waited in an emergency room for 15 hours before I was offered a room with a bed in the middle of the night, and that bed was still in the emergency department. I am grateful that I was eventually admitted to the hospital, but nobody should have to wait in an emergency department that long. I have cancer and an autoimmune disorder. I was exhausted and worried about being exposed to viruses while waiting for such a long time in the emergency department, but had no choice but to be there because I urgently needed health care. Maryland has some of the longest wait times in the nation, and a task force is needed to examine this issue. I urge you to give a favorable report to House Bill 274.
