**POSITION:** Oppose, as drafted

The Maryland Judiciary opposes House Bill 115, as drafted. This bill requires the court to award reasonable attorney's fees and costs to a prevailing plaintiff in this type of case.

The Judiciary traditionally opposes legislation that includes mandatory provisions. The Judiciary believes it is important for judges to weigh the facts and circumstances for each individual case when making a determination. Provisions that place restrictions on the judge prevent the judge from considering factors unique to the case.
