After you have had the courage to come forward and the State's Attorney chooses not to charge your abuser, you should at least be able to understand their decision. Someone should have to face you to help you understand why the decision was made.

To the victim, this is simply acceptable conduct. Although it shouldn't, the victim and their rights are frequently ignored in our society. It would be so easy to at least give the victim the courtesy of being heard by an Assistant State's Attorney.

It is for these reasons the Lower Shore Progressive Caucus supports this bill and recommends a **FAVORABLE** report in committee.
