The Maryland Judiciary supports House Bill 66. As requested by the Clerks of the Court, this bill seeks to increase the amount of the service charge that may be imposed by a circuit court or the District Court for a dishonored check.

Increasing the service charge better reflects the cost and time-consuming process involved when dealing with dishonored checks. The increase from \$10.00 to \$30.00 was determined by matching the fee issued by the Comptroller for a dishonored check.
